



Rules & Regulations of Trinity

on behalf of the Board of Directors.

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1 Rules and Regulations: Multigamingclan

1.1 Preamble

Trinity is an european clan that was founded at the 1st of June 2017. At the date of 24th of May 2020, Trinity became a Multigaming clan. The Rules and Regulations defines the structures and ranks of Trinity, but also the rules and guidelines that are lived inside the clan and its Teams. A Team is an official representation of Trinity in a game which has Competitive as well as Casual aspects. Both playstyles will be covered equally. Trinity is currently representative of the following games:

- Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord (Since 24th May 2020, see 2 Rules and Regulations: Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord)

The English language is used for communication within Trinity. The platform for voice-chatting and the source of information is mainly Discord. We don't have a forum as this will be covered by our Discord server. Everyone is welcome to join our Discord¹ if the rules are followed. In order to join the Clan, a minimum age of 15 must be reached.

1.2 Guidelines

Companionship

With us are all gamers. We value a harmonious community which enjoys to contest in competitive and casual events together. Discrimination, exclusion or insulting behavior will not be tolerated. Everyone can decide for himself/herself what kind of playstyle he/she wishes to take on in the team (competitive or casual) and other games.

With the Departments, all members can make their contribution to the community. No one should feel forced to something but engagement is welcome. To have fun playing together is most important to all of us and so it is the task of each one to contribute to funding and preserving this community. So whether shoulder to shoulder in a heated clan-battle or in a relaxed evening event, we stand together.

Structure

Trinity is a Multigamingclan, which is divided into Teams for the active played games. There are Ranks and Committees in the Clan as well as in the Teams, which mirror the tasks and duties to them. Whereas the rank shows the rights and responsibilities for the Multigamingclan, the Team rank mirrors the role that is taken within it. The Team has its own administration but enjoys the advantages, that the Multigamingclan provides.

Code of Conduct

These rules ensure a peaceful coexistence and professionalism inside and outside of the clan:

1. Discriminating, insulting condescending behavior will not be tolerated.
2. Everyone should treat other clan-members with respect. Which does not mean there is no place for healthy humor.
3. Mental maturity in our community is a precondition.
4. We are aware of the fact, that we all still have a real-life, which always comes first in every case. Yet, it would be good, in a case of longer absence, to notify the clan-management about it. That is especially important for the competitive team.
5. Being a member in multiple clans within a game is prohibited. Exceptions with limitations can be determined by the management.
6. To participate in tournaments and events, their rules must be accepted.

1.3 Ranks

Leader

The Leader represents Trinity and is the highest chain of the organization. (S)he coordinates the clan affairs and is the executive power inside the Trinity. The maximum number of Leaders is 1. The Leader is the CEO of the Board of Directors.



Co-Leader

The Co-Leader assists the Leader with the management of Trinity. The maximum number of Co-Leaders is 2.

The Co-Leader has a seat in the Board of Directors.

Director

The Director has been elected via a direct or indirect² way. As Director, and thereby as member of the Board of Directors, he/she represents his/her team inside. The maximum number of Directors is 3 per team.

The Director has a seat in the Board of Directors.

Officer

The Officer is an elected member (direct or indirect) and has administrative responsibility within a Team or in the Clan.

Senior Member

The Senior Member has been an integral part of the clan for a long time and has proven that moderation rights can be entrusted to him/her on the common Trinity servers.

Regular Member

The Regular Member is a full member of the Clan.

Trial Member

The Trial Member is in the application phase of the clan.

Temporary Member

The Temporary Member is temporarily part of the clan (e.g. as mercenary for a team). He/she is not part of the Clan.

1.4 Committees

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors consists of the Leader, the Co-leaders and the Directors. The Board of Directors takes care of clan administration and internal / external representation of Trinity.

1.5 Departments

A Department offers members the opportunity to actively participate in clan life and take on responsibilities. A Department consists of an admin and his/her members. The person in charge must be at least an Officer (or higher) - with the exception of the Server Department. Otherwise, direct elections for the ranks are available. Following offices are available:

Media Department

The Media Department is responsible for creating media content. These include: graphics, videos, streams (e.g. Twitch), YouTube etc.

Website Department

The Website Department is responsible for the creation and maintenance of the website, the clanthreads etc.

Server Department

The Server Department administrates and moderates the servers and their regulations, which Trinity owns as a clan. The Server Department works closely with the Board of Directors and the Teams (f.e. managing regulations and appointments of moderators).

Prerequisite for the Head: Director (possible via direct election)

1.6 Elections and Decisions

In order to prove the administrative ranks within the clan or in the individual teams, elections have to take place. Officers or executives (Director or higher) have a responsibility to carry out their work. Officers can be proposed to the Board of Directors by the Regular Members (or higher). Elections take place



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every six months if there is a significant need. Otherwise, vacant positions can take place at any time through extraordinary elections. Only Regular Members (or higher) are allowed to vote.

Decisions are made within the bodies of the clan and the individual teams. Decisions mean changes to the Rules, structures and decrees (orders).

To ensure agility, decisions and elections run for 3 days. Elections and decisions can even be reduced to 2 days if 80% of the seats occupied have already taken part in the vote. With 100% participation, the vote is ended prematurely. A vote is considered ratified if 70 % of the participants voted in favour.



2 Rules and Regulations: Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord

This section specifies the more detailed structure of the Trinity Team for the game Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord. These Rules and Regulations bases on the concent defined in "Rules and Regulations: Multigamingclan". In this section, the name Team will be used as equivalence in order to simplify references.

2.1 Ranks

Archduke / Archduchess

The Archduke/Archduchess is the leader of the Team and represents the Team inside the game. The maximum number of Archduke/Archduchess is 1.

The Archduke/Archduchess has a seat inside the Administrative Council (AC) and Advisory Board (AB).

The Archduke/Archduchess has the rank Director inside Trinity.

Duke / Duchess

The Duke/Duchess is part of the management of the team and coordinates the Team with the Archduke. The maximum number of Duke/Duchess is 2. The Duke/Duchess has a seat inside the Administrative Council (AC) and Advisory Board (AB).

The Duke/Duchess has the rank Director inside Trinity.

Earl / Countess

The Earl/Countess is an officer of the Team and assists the Teamleadership with their tasks.

The Earl/Countess has a seat inside the Administrative Council (AC) and Advisory Board (AB) .

The Earl/Countess has the rank Officer inside Trinity.



Knight

The Knight is longer an integral part of the team and has moderate permissions on the team-side servers.

The Knight has a seat inside the Advisory Board (AB).

The Knight has the rank Senior Member inside Trinity.

Soldier

The Soldier is a full member of the team.

The Soldier has the rank Regular Member inside Trinity.

Recruit

The Recruit is an applicant of the Trinity Clan and is in the test phase. The test phase usually lasts about 2 to 3 weeks.

The Recruit has the rank Trial Member inside Trinity.

Mercenary

The Mercenary is not part of the clan and is part of the Team for a limited time. Thereby he/she has not the rights and obligations of a Regular Member.

The Mercenary has the rank Temporary Member inside Trinity.

2.2 Committees

Administrative Council (AC)

The Administrative Council is the Officer Committee, occupied by the stands Earl and higher, and is responsible for the administrative affairs of the Team.

Advisory Board (AB)

The Advisory Board is the Advisory Committee consisting of the Knights and higher. The committee supports the Administrative Council and, in addition to the right to vote on larger decisions, also has the right to participate in the decision-making process when accepting members.



2.3 Departments

A Department offers the members the opportunity to actively participate in the Team organization and to take responsibility on the part of the (Arch)Dukes. A Department consists of an admin and his/her members. Vacant places are taken over by the Administrative Council. The following positions are planned for the team:

Recruitment Department

The Recruitment Department is responsible for the promotion and execution of the recruitment process.

Prerequisite for the Head: Rank Knight (or higher)

Match Department

The Match Department takes care of the organization as well as the execution of official matches, regular scrims and training. *Prerequisite for the Head:* Rank Knight (or higher)

Event Department

The Event Department organizes participation in events that do not directly represent the competitive aspects of the team. The department also creates its own events and takes care of managing the achievements system within the Team.

Prerequisite for the Head: Rank Knight (or higher)

2.4 Motivation of Members

2.4.1 Division into Competitive and Casual

Members are free to choose at any time to belong to the competitive or the casual team. The difference between the two types of participation is primarily limited to joining official events:

The competitive Team takes part in regular events of the match-department and are preferred in the official matches.



The regular participation in the events of the match-department is free for the casual team.

2.4.2 Events

The team organizes own events in Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord and participates in external ones as well. The event-department takes over the organization for this.

2.4.3 Hungergames

Trinity gained reputation with the Hungergames Mod in Mount and Blade: Warband. A successor to the mod is being developed as part of Trinity for Mount and Blade 2: Bannerlord. The members of the Clan enjoy advantages and, if interested, can actively / easily participate in the development, maintenance and event organization of the mod and its servers.

2.4.4 Achievements

Achievements are medals and badges that are awarded to members for special events during membership. These are managed and displayed on the usual platforms. The Event Department manages the achievements in a delegation of the management and can only be awarded to Soldiers or higher. Badges refer to membership activities and can be earned in both casual and competitive areas, while medals can only be earned through competitive goals. The following achievements are available:

Badge of Loyalty The member has been part of the team for 6 (bronze) / 12 (silver) / 24 (gold) months.

Badge of Engagement The member has been active in 2 (bronze) / 3 (silver) / 4 (gold) Departments or in administrative positions for at least 2 months.

Medal for Performance The member played in 2 (bronze) / 3 (silver) / 4 (gold) tournaments within the top 3 in Trinity.



Medal for Participation The member played in 3 (bronze) / 4 (silver) / 5 (gold) leagues.

Badge of Honor The member receives a badge of honor for a very special achievement. *Can be suggested by Knights or higher on the Advisory Board (AB); Badges of honor must be justified and ratified through the Advisory Board (AB)*
